



Burapha University Announcement
On the Policy of Refraining from Giving and Receiving Any Kind of Gift or Any
Other Benefits regarding Responsible Duty (No Gift Policy)
B.E. 2569

According to the model scheme of National Strategic Plan (21) on Anti-Corruption and Misconduct (B.E. 2561 – 2580) Strategic concerning sub-issue on Prevention of Corruption and Misconduct Section 2, “Encourage the performance of civil officials and state officers to be clean and refrain any circumstance that likely to be corruption”

Burapha University shall implement this policy to refrain from giving and receiving gifts or any kinds of gifts or any other benefits regarding responsible duty (No Gift Policy) to all levels and positions of the university officials consistently. Therefore, the university enacted an announcement in detail as follows:

Article 1. University official shall not receive any kinds of gifts or any other benefits that likely to be a corruptive behavior or being discriminated against someone regarding responsible duty.

Article 2. University official shall not receive any kinds of gifts or any other benefits that likely to be a corruptive behavior or being discriminated against someone regarding gaining personal benefits.

Article 3. University official shall not receive or give any kind of gifts or any other benefits to the university visitors.

Article 4. University official shall not seek for gaining unlawful gifts or any kind of gifts or any other benefits.

Article 5. Receiving or giving gifts based on festive season, tradition, culture or other essential occasions shall be done in accordance with regulations, orders, or announcements of the university.

Article 6. University official shall distribute this policy thoroughly to outsiders.
